These digital stickers are also responsible for the popularity of Asian app giants like LINE, WeChat, and KakaoTalk. For example, LINE, a service with more than 400 million registered users, sold stickers worth a total of nearly \$70 million in 2013, making up twenty percent of its total earnings that year.

Now, these services are looking to enter the North American market, and whether or not they'll be successful depends largely on the fate of these stickers across the ocean. Stickers are popular in Asia because they can be used as a sort of visual shorthand. Typing Asian characters using smartphones designed with the Latin alphabet may be tiring. Stickers let users communicate quickly and efficiently without using strings of characters. With stickers, users can also express ideas indirectly, thus avoiding embarrassment or offending people. For example, to decline someone's invitation to dinner, one could send a sticker to get that message across in a cute way, rather than saying "no" or "I can't" outright.

(B) The lost art of hand-painted movie billboard is still alive in the memories of many movie fanatics in Taiwan. In Taiwan, hand-painted movie billboard can date back to the Japanese rule period. In the 1960s when the political and social environment were stable, people had more time to engage in recreational activities. As a result, hand-painted movie billboards became a popular trend. In the 1980s, however, due to the gradual development of photo printing and color printing technologies and its relatively low cost, the trend of hand-painted poster art slowly died out in favor of the newly improved glossy, digitally-produced posters. Today, only two theaters exist in Taiwan that insist on keeping up the tradition, giving Taiwanese movie billboard painter Sen-Shan Hsieh the chance to showcase and pass down his artistic talent to others.

Born in 1946, Hsieh began practicing painting at the age of 15 and has to this day accumulated up to 50 years of experience in bringing Chinese and Western movie stars, cartoon characters, and movie scenes to life on posters.
