After recovering from a vicious attack in Pakistan, Malala Yousafzai spoke at the United Nations. In a speech that was heard everywhere, she demanded education for everyone.

Two years later, Malala Yousafzai and another person were jointly presented with the Nobel Peace Prize. At 17, Malala had become the youngest person to ever receive it, and she offered these words.
