The nation is just over half the size of Taiwan and has a population of only two million. Despite its smallness, Slovenia has a lot to offer tourists. Two of the country's natural wonders are Lake Bled and Postojna Cave, which are separated from each other by less than an hour's drive. Scenic Lake Bled, with its surrounding hills and forests, is a perfect place to unwind. Visitors to the area can also enjoy Bled Castle, which is perched on a tall hill overlooking the lake. The castle's architecture is interesting, complete with a drawbridge and moat. The museum and exhibition rooms inside the building are especially attractive to history buffs eager to see what life was like in Medieval Europe. Meanwhile, Postojna Cave stretches for 24 kilometers, five kilometers of which are open to the public. So large is the cave that in some parts, a concert hall was constructed inside, which can entertain as many as 10,000 people at symphony orchestra performances.

Making a triangle with Postojna Cave and Lake Bled is the capital, Ljubljana. Much of the city is like an outdoor museum with architecture that has been preserved for centuries. Ljubljana's counterparts, such as London, Paris, and Rome, may be bigger, but the Slovenian capital has a clean, convenient, and calming environment. In addition to the medieval treasure called Ljubljana Castle, the twin-towered Ljubljana Cathedral, the Town Hall, and the Urbanc House are other must-see attractions. All in all, Slovenia is a beautiful and affordable destination that people should put on their bucket lists.
