An "amputee" is a person who has had part of their body cut off, or "amputated." It may be one or both of their arms or legs, and may have been lost in an accident or cut off in an operation to stop the spread of disease. Many amputees say they can still feel body parts that are no longer there. These lost legs or arms can itch or ache, or even feel as if they are moving.

Some scientists believe there is an explanation for this experience. They say a person's brain holds a "map" of their body. The body continues to send information to the brain about arms and legs even when they are gone. Sometimes, this feeling is helpful when the amputee is being given an artificial limb. It allows them to adapt to the new arm or leg more quickly.

Many amputees have overcome the loss of legs and arms and done great things. One example is Tom Whittaker, the first disabled person to climb the world's highest mountain. He had lost his right foot in an accident. Another is Alex Zanardi, an Italian whose career as a racing driver continued even after he had lost both his legs.
