Have you ever been on your way somewhere in a big hurry, only to be delayed by a traffic accident or road construction? Imagine being notified of those problems as you are on the road. Smart traffic cameras could be set up to communicate with one another to create an efficient citywide transportation system or an even larger framework. Through such a system, drivers could receive instructions sent to traffic signs about the best routes to take. All of this and more are possible because of the Internet of Things (IoT). The term IoT was coined in 1999 by British businessman Kevin Ashton. However, the concept of connected devices has been talked about at least since the 1970s, long before the development of the Net made the Internet of Things a definite possibility.

With the advances in computer communication such as cloud computing and other networks, the IoT has a lot of potential to provide a complete transformation of how we live our lives. It is certain, though, that simple sensors embedded in physical things can become far grander.
