- 2. The great white shark, considered the most dangerous of all sharks, inhabits temperate waters throughout the world's seas. A grown shark may reach a length of twenty feet or more and weigh up to three tons. Its triangular teeth grow to lengths of two inches or more and are extraordinarily strong. Though judging from stomach contents, the predator can indeed devour prey whole, it is a

finicky eater. In fact, it prefers to feed on whales, sea lions, and seals rather than humans, birds, and sea otters because the latter lack the layers of fat possessed by larger prey. That is why it often spits out humans and lets them go after the attack since it finds them not to its taste.

- 3. A visit to Rwanda would not be complete without a visit with the fascinating mountain gorillas. Gorilla Nest Lodge provides a base to do just that. It lies in the Ruhengeri region at the base of Virunga Mountain and just 2km from the Volcanoes National Park headquarters. It takes about an hour and a half to travel to the lodge in north Rwanda, which is right on the outskirts of the gorilla sanctuary and is one of the most beautiful drives you'll ever see. Terraced hillsides, lush green valleys and waterfalls are seen on both sides of the well-paved two-lane road. The Gorilla Nest Lodge is a luxury hotel that blends into the jungle. Permits to see the gorillas cost USD500 per person, but are worth every minute of the experience. The mountain gorillas in the park have 97 percent of the same DNA as humans and are amazing creatures. Like humans, they eat, sleep, play and nurture their young. The money from the permits helps the rangers protect the gorillas, continue research and assist the surrounding communities with building schools, health clinics and crafts centers.

Visiting Rwanda requires vaccinations, passports and time – all well worth it. It's a small country that is packed with adventure, beauty and a rich tradition of welcoming visitors with open arms.

- 4. Actors like Gugu Mbatha-Raw do not come around often, not simply because of her talent but also because of her sense of artistic responsibility. It's clear by the films she chooses that speaking the truth and giving a voice to the unheard are goals that she takes seriously.

This talented performer was involved with different kinds of dance at a young age, as well as music and drama. This led her to the Royal Academy of Dramatic Art, to London's West End, to New York's Broadway, and finally to work in films in Hollywood. Mbatha-Raw is the daughter of a black South African man and white British woman, and she does not feel trapped by this background. Instead, she takes pride in it with films such as Belle, named after her biracial character who lived during the 1700s.

In the 2014 film Beyond the Lights, she portrays a burned-out pop star who once again finds value in her life after trying to kill herself. This type of character shows Mbatha-Raw's desire to play not simply strong women but complicated people. It also reveals that celebrities have their own struggles that must be remembered and addressed.

At the same time, Mbatha-Raw does not wish to spend all her time making heavy dramas but likes to have some fun as well. This healthy attitude has resulted in parts such as Plumette, Beauty and the Beast's feather duster. Next year, she will also star in a science-fiction film based on the classic book A Wrinkle in Time. It's likely that Mbatha-Raw will only continue to amaze and teach us.
