Their tentacles, the long string-like structures trap food. Jellyfish are able to smell, taste and remain balanced in the water. This last characteristic is very important, as they have a unique style for swimming. As water is pushed in one direction, the jellyfish move in the opposite direction.

Jellyfish are best known and avoided because of their stinging cells, on their tentacles and other body parts. The stinging cells are used to sting, capture and subdue prey. Their sting is so strong that even a jellyfish that has been washed ashore cannot be handled, as it still stings. The stings of some jellyfish may cause reactions ranging from mild rashes to death. Although feared by swimmers, most jellyfish are harmless to human beings. In fact, these graceful creatures can benefit people. Several different kinds of jellyfish are being used to treat certain kinds of cancer and heart diseases. They are also beneficial to other animals, offering shelter in open water for tiny fish and crabs that travel safely under their jellyfish host.
