A study on the way smartphones interfere with learning might help us understand the issue. In April 2017, researchers explored the differences in student performance in four different settings. Students watched a 20-minute video, then took a short quiz. Students in a room without any cellphones performed significantly better than students who had phones present. Even if the phones were turned off.

We now live in an age when many people experience anxiety caused by not having a phone – nomophobia. This is the powerful feeling people get when they don't have signal, their battery is about to die, or they are separated from their phone. Scientists think that this isn't just because of an addiction to information. They believe not having a constant connection via social media and news makes us feel left out. And this can distract us even if the phone is turned off.

But, can unlimited information also hinder the way we think? In the past, people relied heavily on their friends' knowledge. They knew who in their circle of friends or acquaintances would be most likely to know things in different subjects.

Now, our friend with all the information is the internet. But, people don't retain information as well if they know they can use a computer or phone to recall it quickly. The funny thing is that people who often use digital devices feel more informed even though they may retain less information.

But being exposed to lots of information isn't all bad. Frequent internet use can strengthen fast-paced problem solving, and speed up the ability to spot patterns in a lot of data.
