The Left-Handers Club was formed in 1990 aiming to keep members in touch with developments, make their opinions known to producers and others, provide a help to promote research into left-handedness and development of new left-handed items. On 13th August 1992 the Club launched International Left-Handers Day, an annual event when left-handers everywhere can celebrate their uniqueness and increase public awareness of the advantages and disadvantages of being left-handed. Born in 1977, Namie spent her early childhood in Okinawa, far from the bright lights of Japan's big cities. At the age of 15, being selected to join Super Monkey's and moving to Tokyo changed Namie's life completely. In 1995, Super Monkey's ended their entertaining career; however, Namie's star kept rising and had her first number-one single. Two years later, she had won several awards and sold 20 million records in total. At just 20 years old, Namie was on top of the world.
