Because International, founded by Kenton Lee, is an organization whose mission is to **leverage** innovation to try to make things better. They believe that the positive cycle of innovation can fight the negative cycle of poverty. Their first innovation, The Shoe That Grows, is a shoe that can grow with a growing foot.

In fact, Kenton had the idea ten years ago when he was living at an orphanage in Kenya. One day while walking with all the children, he was shocked to spot a girl whose shoes were so small that she had to cut open the front of her shoes to let her toes stick out. Faced with lots of rejection and obstacles, Because International got through the design, made the prototype, got it tested, and distributed the great first batch of growing shoes to children around the world.
