(C) Known as Boxing Day, it started in Great Britain and spread to the former colonies of the British Empire, including Canada, Australia, and South Africa. In most of these places it's also an official holiday, which is helpful to those who need an extra day to recover from having eaten and drunk too much on Christmas Day!

The origin of the holiday's name is unclear, but everyone agrees that it has nothing to do with the fighting sport. One theory is that hundreds of years ago it was traditional to give servants—who had to work on Christmas—box of money or gifts to thank them for their service. Others say it comes from a practice of setting out a box for charity in December. This would then be opened the day after Christmas so that the money could be given to the needy.

Boxing Day celebrations vary from country to country, though most people treat the holiday as an extra day to relax with friends and family. Many countries feature major sporting events like soccer matches, hockey games, and horse racing. In other countries, people take advantage of the post-Christmas sales that begin on Boxing Day.

There are also those who **observe** the charitable roots of the holiday. In South Africa, where the name of the holiday was changed to the Day of Goodwill, people donate money, clothes, and food to those in need. Some in the United Kingdom add a bit of silliness to the day by taking part in the Boxing Day Dip. This involves diving into the cold sea, often in fancy dress and sometimes in a Santa hat, to raise money for different causes.
