(II) For everyday purpose, we rely partially on our memories and partially on our small helpers: agendas, notebooks, calendars, etc. to remember what we have to do. One of these valuable helpers, Post-it, the self sticking notes came as a result of a failure and some scrap paper. 3M researcher Art Fry enjoyed singing in church, but he could not keep the little pieces of paper he used to mark his favorite songs in the same place. However, Fry was a creative and **resourceful** person. He remembered there was a kind of glue, invented by another 3M scientist, which was rejected because it could not hold things together for a long time. Eventually, he introduced the product by giving free samples to customers, but demand for Post-it notes grew quickly.

The latest development has been crossing a Post-it note with a computer, called Post-it Software Notes. It is a digital version of the yellow notes, and it is perfect for quick reminders on your computer desktop, so you will never miss a meeting, event or thought. You can also use it to exchange notes with your friends on the Internet. This little aid for communication came a long way from the scrap papers and rejected glue.

Parts of Tiangong-1 conveniently splashed down not far from the world's 'spacecraft cemetery'

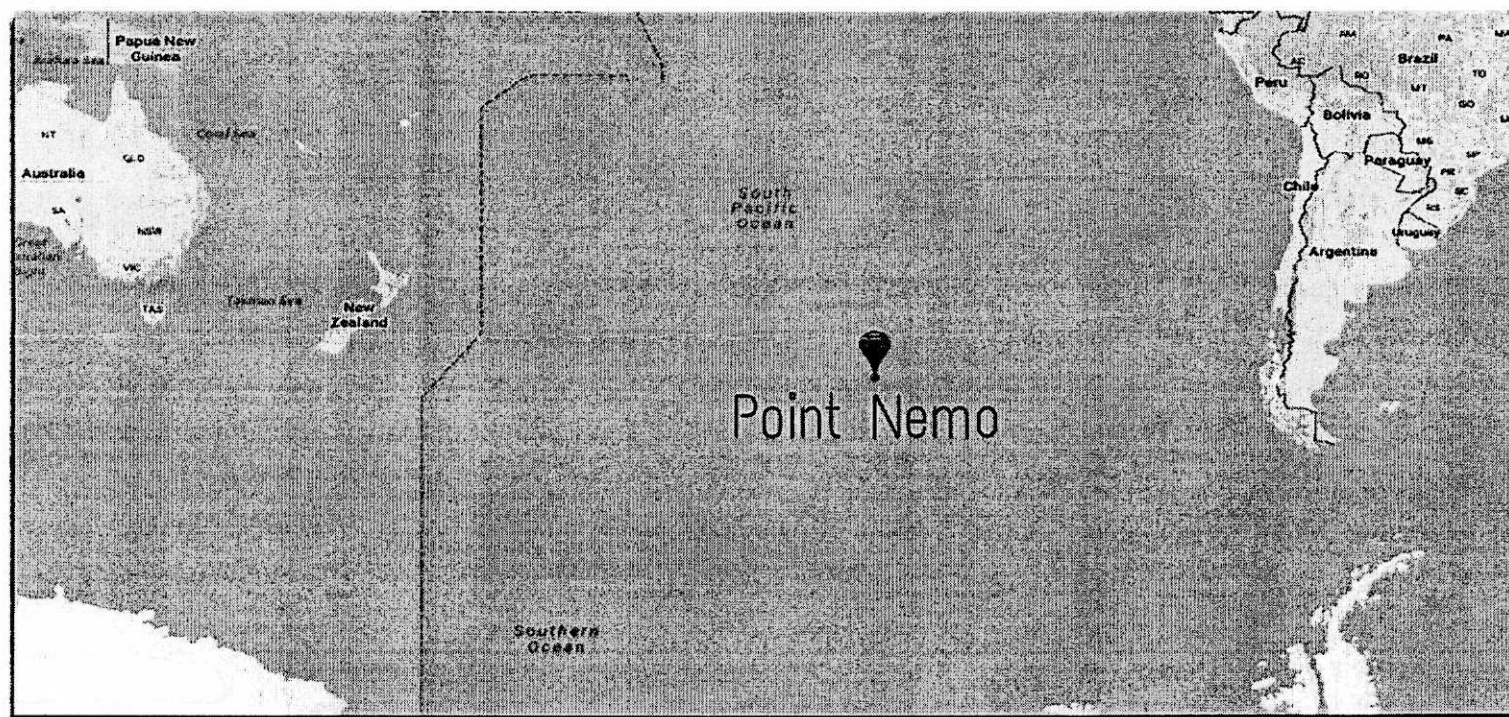
NOT far from Australia is the world's "spacecraft cemetery" known as Point Nemo — considered the most remote place on Earth.

CHINA'S out-of-control space station plummeted back to Earth this morning and, as it turns out, it landed not too far from a famous resting place for old satellites and spacecraft.

Officials confirmed this morning that the defunct space station Tiangong-1 mostly burned up upon re-entry into Earth's atmosphere and landed in the South Pacific at about 10.16am AEST.

At about 2400km from any spot of land, it's "pretty much the farthest place from any human civilization you can find," according to NASA and that's precisely why space agencies around the world like to use it as a dumping ground for spacecraft that once orbited above us.

Though not all spacecraft end up in a watery grave in the vast stretch of the South Pacific Ocean. Many smaller satellites don't make it because the heat from the friction of the air burns up the satellite as it falls towards Earth at thousands of kilometers an hour.
