(B) Wouldn't you like to get a job with a salary of AU\$150,000 for six months? What's even better, you can live on a tropical island __21__ by a beautiful sea with abundant marine life. (C) There are actually two Formosa on the earth. By remarkable coincidence, the two places are antipodal __28__ each other. One is Taiwan, __29__ in a complex area between two plates and the other __29__ on the banks of Paraguay River in Argentina. Now, let's take a close look at these two Formosas. Taiwan boasts a variety of landforms and wildlife, some of __30__ are unique to Taiwan. Two-thirds of its 36,000 square kilometers are covered by mountains with dense forests. (A) After the ice-making submarine received the reward, however, the science behind the design came __36__ criticism. He is scared by almost everything, particularly ghosts, and is a cry-baby. He dislikes going on outdoor activities instead of having afternoon naps and reading comics, usually right after school. Even though he has many flaws, he is kind-hearted, emotional, honest, occasionally hard-working and sometimes courageous. He has often risked his life to help save others.

Doraemon's original paint color was yellow. After getting his ears gnawed off by a robot mouse at the 22nd century, he accidentally drank a potion labeled "sadness". As he wept, the yellow color washed off and his voice changed due to the potion. As a result, he developed a morbid fear of mice despite being a robotic cat. His favorite food is *dorayaki*, a Japanese treat filled with red bean paste.

Shizuka Minamoto is a smart, kind, pretty and quiet girl. She is Nobita's best friend and does not avoid him due to his failing grades, lazy disposition or constant failures. In fact, she often tries to encourage him to do better, though she usually fails to convince him. She likes to take a bath several times a day. Her true passion is the violin, in which her playing is even more horrendous than Takeshi Goda's singing. She is also known for taking piano lessons unwillingly due to her mother's wishes, which is sometimes a reason for declining to hang out with friends.

Takeshi Goda is a strong and quick-tempered local bully. He also frequently steals other children's stuff under the pretext of "borrowing" them, unless the toy is damaged. He is known for his horrible singing voice, though he considers himself a great singer. To prove this, he sometimes "invites" others to attend his concerts, under the threat of beatings. He is also confident in cooking, but just like his singing, his hand-made food can be a nightmare for other people very easily. However, he does not hesitate to help his friends when they are in real trouble.

Suneo Honekawa is the fox-faced rich child who loves to flaunt his material wealth before everyone, especially Nobita. A lot of the stories start with his showing off some new video game, toy or pet which evokes Nobita's envy. He sometimes despises Nobita and often makes fun of him, most often resulting in his getting into trouble. He also tries to face as little trouble as possible and go home, unless others convince him, making him somewhat a coward. He has an extensive knowledge of science, and is a talented artist and designer, besides being extremely cunning.

Can cold weather and snow kill the novel coronavirus in human body?	There is no reason to believe that cold weather can kill the new coronavirus or other diseases. The normal human body temperature remains around 36.5°C to 37°C, regardless of the external temperature or weather. The most effective way to protect yourself against the new coronavirus is by frequently cleaning your hands with alcohol-based hand rub or washing them with soap and water.
Can taking a hot bath prevent the new coronavirus disease?	Taking a hot bath will not prevent you from catching COVID-19. Your normal body temperature remains around 36.5°C to 37°C, regardless of the temperature of your bath or shower. Actually, taking a hot bath with extremely hot water can be harmful, as it can burn you. The best way to protect yourself against COVID-19 is by frequently cleaning your hands. By doing this you eliminate viruses that may be on your hands and avoid infection that could occur by touching your eyes, mouth, and nose.
Are hand dryers effective in killing the new coronavirus?	No. Hand dryers are not effective in killing the 2019-nCoV. To protect yourself against the new coronavirus, you should frequently clean your hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or wash them with soap and water. Once your hands are cleaned, you should dry them thoroughly by using paper towels or a warm air dryer.
Can spraying alcohol or chlorine all over your body kill the novel coronavirus?	No. Spraying alcohol or chlorine all over your body will not kill viruses that have already entered your body. Spraying such substances can be harmful to clothes or mucous membranes (i.e. eyes, mouth). Be aware that both alcohol and chlorine can be useful to disinfect surfaces, but they need to be used under appropriate recommendations.
