Green Chemistry is the design of chemical products and processes that reduces or eliminates the use or production of hazardous substances. Green chemistry applies across the entire chemical product, including its design, manufacture, use, and disposal. Green chemistry is also known as sustainable chemistry. It prevents pollution at the molecular level. It uses new scientific solutions to solve real-world environmental problems. It reduces the negative impacts of chemical products and process on human health and the environment. Green Chemistry reduces pollution at its source, by minimizing or eliminating the hazards of the entire production process. It is unlike cleaning up pollution, which involves treating waste streams or cleaning up environmental spills. Green Chemistry keeps the hazardous materials out of the environment in the first place. Green Chemistry has 12 principles.
