Deepfakes (a portmanteau of "deep learning" and "fake") are synthetic media __(66)__ a person in an existing image or video is (67) with someone else's likeness. While the act of faking content is not new, deepfakes leverage(借助) powerful techniques from machine learning and artificial intelligence to manipulate or __(68)__ visual and audio content with a high potential to deceive. (I) The German artist Albrecht Dürer is often discussed side by side with the great Italian painter Leonardo da Vinci. Both of these men were born during the fifteenth century and died fairly early in the sixteenth century. Like Leonardo da Vinci, Dürer was highly skilled at painting and drawing, and like Leonardo da Vinci not only learned the traditional painting and drawing methods but also developed them further. Both men had other important interests as well. Dürer studied mathematics and developed theories about its relationship with art; Leonardo da Vinci created magnificent sculptures and used his knowledge of mechanical principles and engineering to design fascinating devices and machines for both civil and military use.

Like Leonardo da Vinci, Dürer was also deeply fascinated with nature. Both Leonardo da Vinci and Dürer chose subjects from nature for many of their works of art. Dürer studied animals before including them in his drawings and paintings, and so did Leonardo da Vinci. In Leonardo's works, the animals' individual muscles are clearly shown. In Dürer's drawings, even the individual hairs on the animals' bodies can be seen. This feature of Dürer's art greatly influenced other artists of his day.

Dürer and Leonardo da Vinci differed in important ways as well. Unlike Leonardo da Vinci, Dürer demonstrated a deep interest in human psychology. This is clear from the many self-portraits that he drew and painted at different times during his lifetime. In each one, he reveals something different about himself. Leonardo da Vinci, on the other hand, focused on understanding the world around him and representing it in his works of art.

Judging by their art, Dürer was also more interested in religion than Leonardo da Vinci was. Many of Dürer's subjects are religious. The most famous example is his painting of praying hands. He also drew and painted people and scenes from the Bible. In addition, Dürer actively supported religious leaders of his time. His popular drawings of religious subjects were widely printed and distributed throughout Germany. They helped to fuel a religious movement that eventually spread throughout Europe and the world.

- GPS technology to keep a record of the path of the pilgrimage from 2008 to 2010 and investigated the total walking distance covered each day. Conventionally, over a period of nine days and eight nights, the pilgrims depart from Taichung, moving southwards to Chiayi during the first three days to attend a blessing party on the fourth day. Then they depart on their journey back to Taichung. The research results showed that the total walking distance ranged from 280 to 330 km each year. Interestingly, in 2010, when 27 more temples joined in and one more day was added to the journey, the total walking distance didn't significantly increase. Instead, the team spent more time at temples along the route and slowed down their speed in the last four days. In all the years, the longest daily walking distance fell on the second day. On that day, the sedan chair always passed Changhua, where one third of the temples visited on the pilgrimage were located. The second longest walking distance fell on the fifth day, probably because the pilgrims had gained more energy from resting on the fourth day. These research results shine light on the traditions of the Mazu Pilgrimage and provide useful information for future pilgrimage planning.
